





- Maintains Provider Payments
- Maintains Existing Service Levels
- Provides Funds to Continue Supplemental Payments for Specialized Hospital Services

FY 2013-14 Governor's Enacted Budget (cont'd.)



- Reflects Actuarially Sound Rate Increase for MCOs (PH and BH)
- Legislation Extended Both the Statewide and Philadelphia Hospital Assessments Through June 30, 2016
