Health IT Initiative

- The Medicaid EHR incentive payment program, created by the American Reinvestment and Recovery Act of 2009 and administered by CMS, provides enhanced match to states to develop and administer provider incentive programs
- States receive 90/10 percent match for program administration expenses and 100 percent federal match for the provider incentive payments
- The Medicaid EHR incentive program encourages provider adoption, implementation, and meaningful use of EHRs

Health IT Initiative

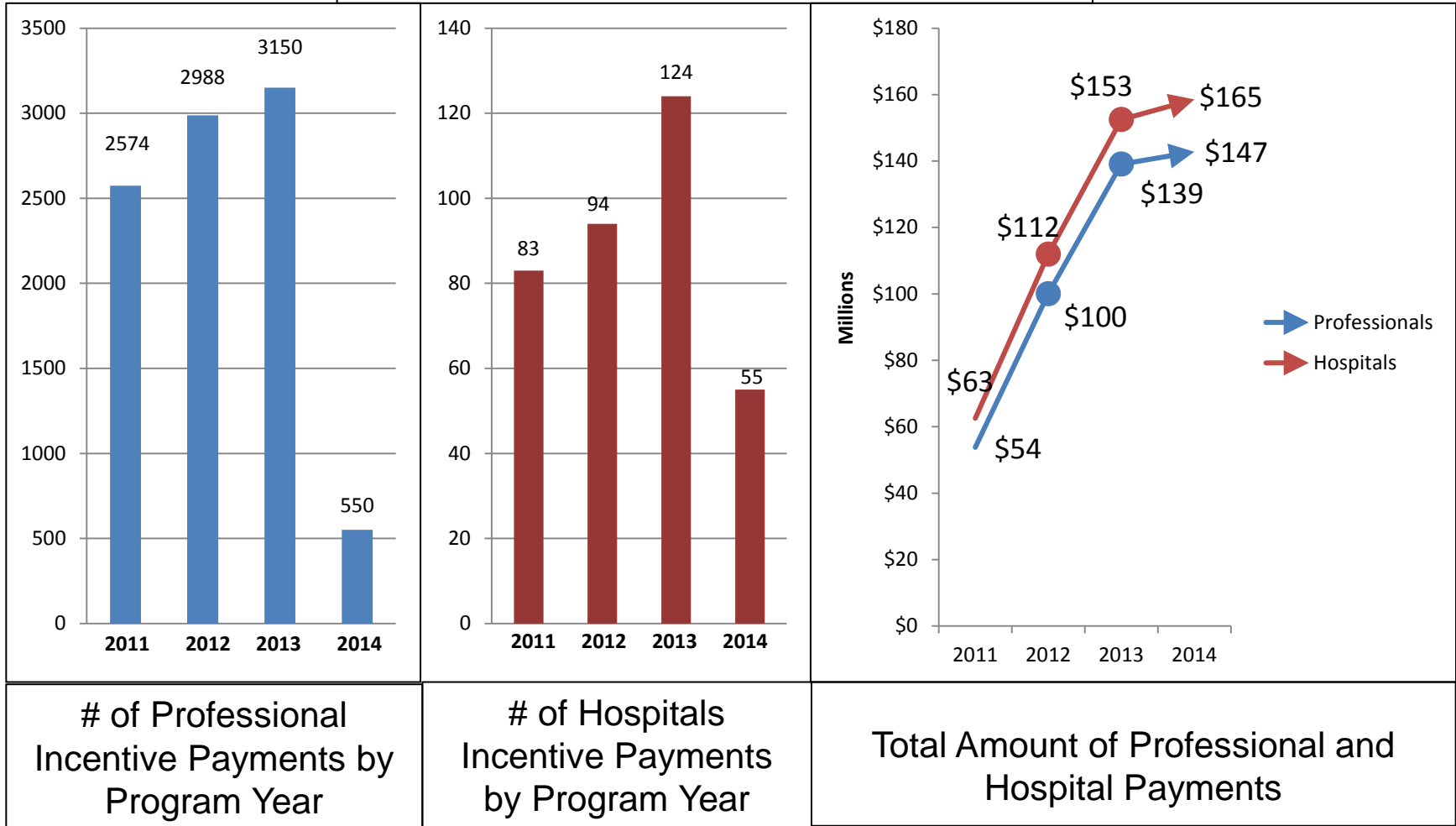
- **MISSION & VISION:** OMAP's vision and strategy for implementing HIT initiatives, including the Medical Assistance EHR incentive program, is to position Pennsylvania as a leader among state Medical Assistance programs in the use of electronic health care information to improve the quality and cost-effectiveness of service delivery for Medical Assistance consumers
- **HIT INITIATIVE GOAL:** To improve the quality and coordination of care by connecting providers to patient information at the point of care through the meaningful use of EHRs
- **eHEALTH PARTNERSHIP AUTHORITY PURPOSE:** To improve healthcare delivery and healthcare outcomes in Pennsylvania by enabling the secure exchange of electronic health information (eHIE)

Health IT Initiative

- We created the MAPIR system for the application process. MAPIR is directly linked with PROMISe
- The PA EHR Incentive program accepted the first application on June 6, 2011 for either adopting, implementing or upgrading to a certified EHR System
- In 2012 we began accepting Meaningful Use applications

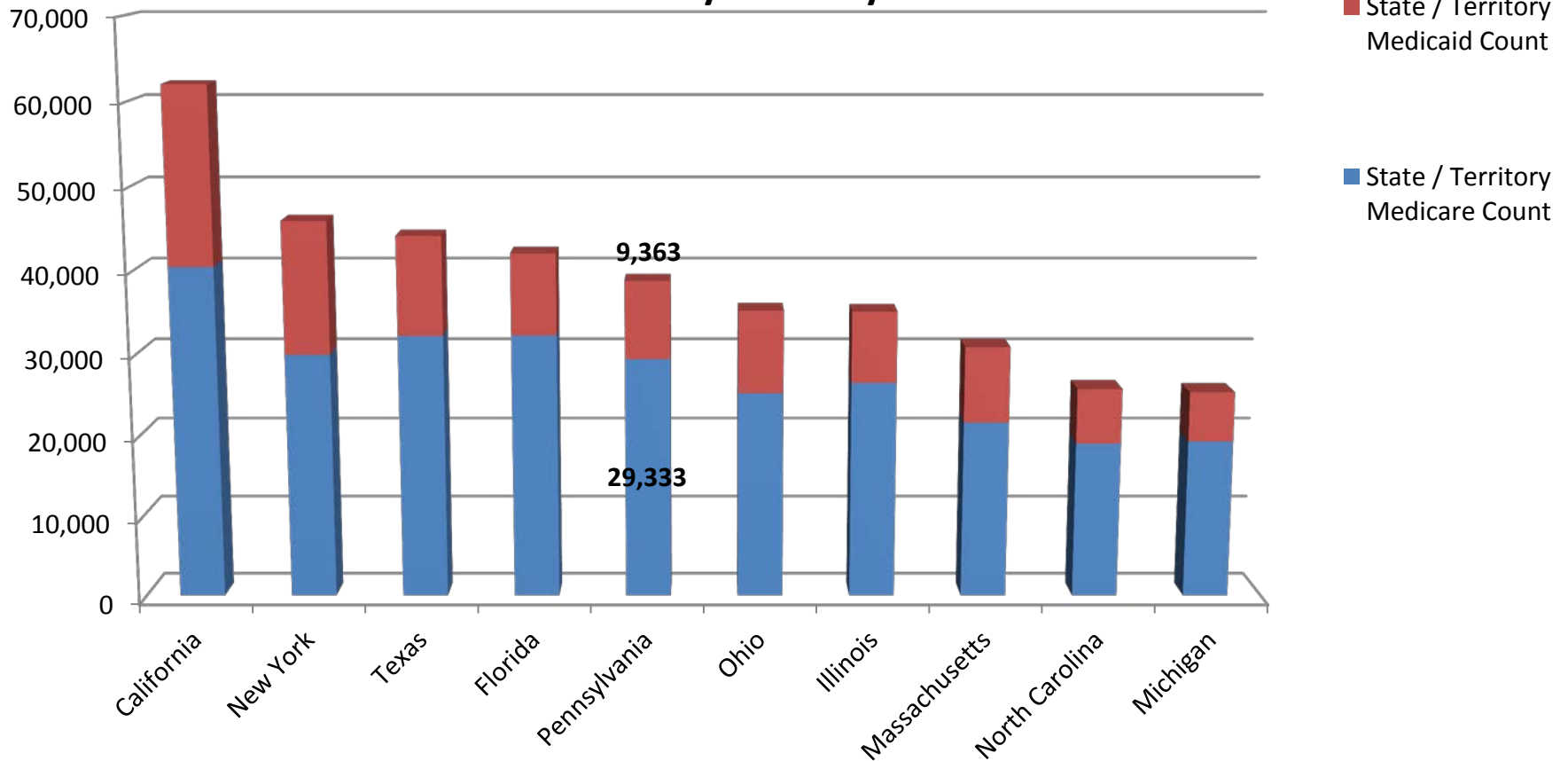
MA EHR Incentive Program Update

National Perspective

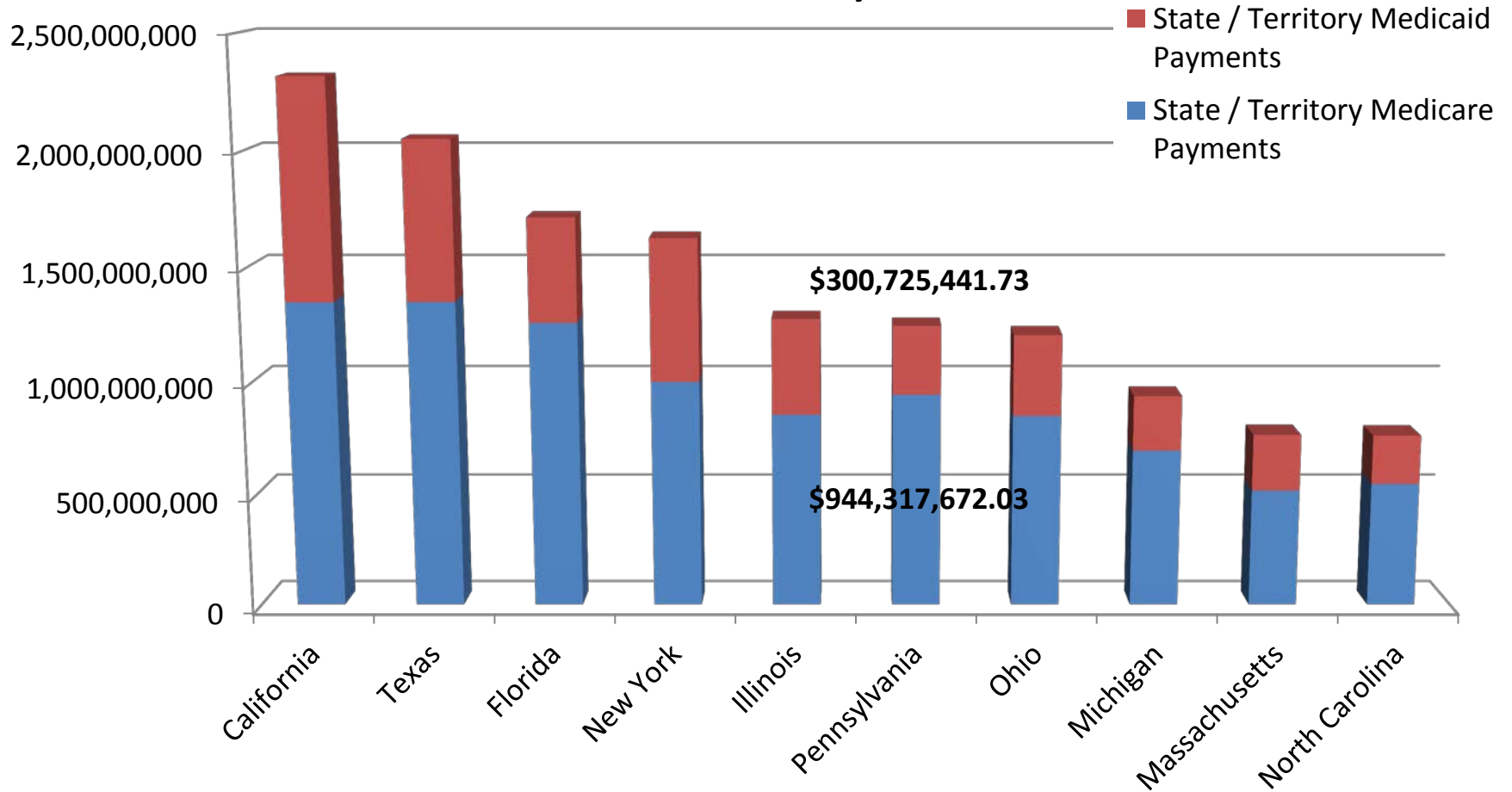
Total Payments by State

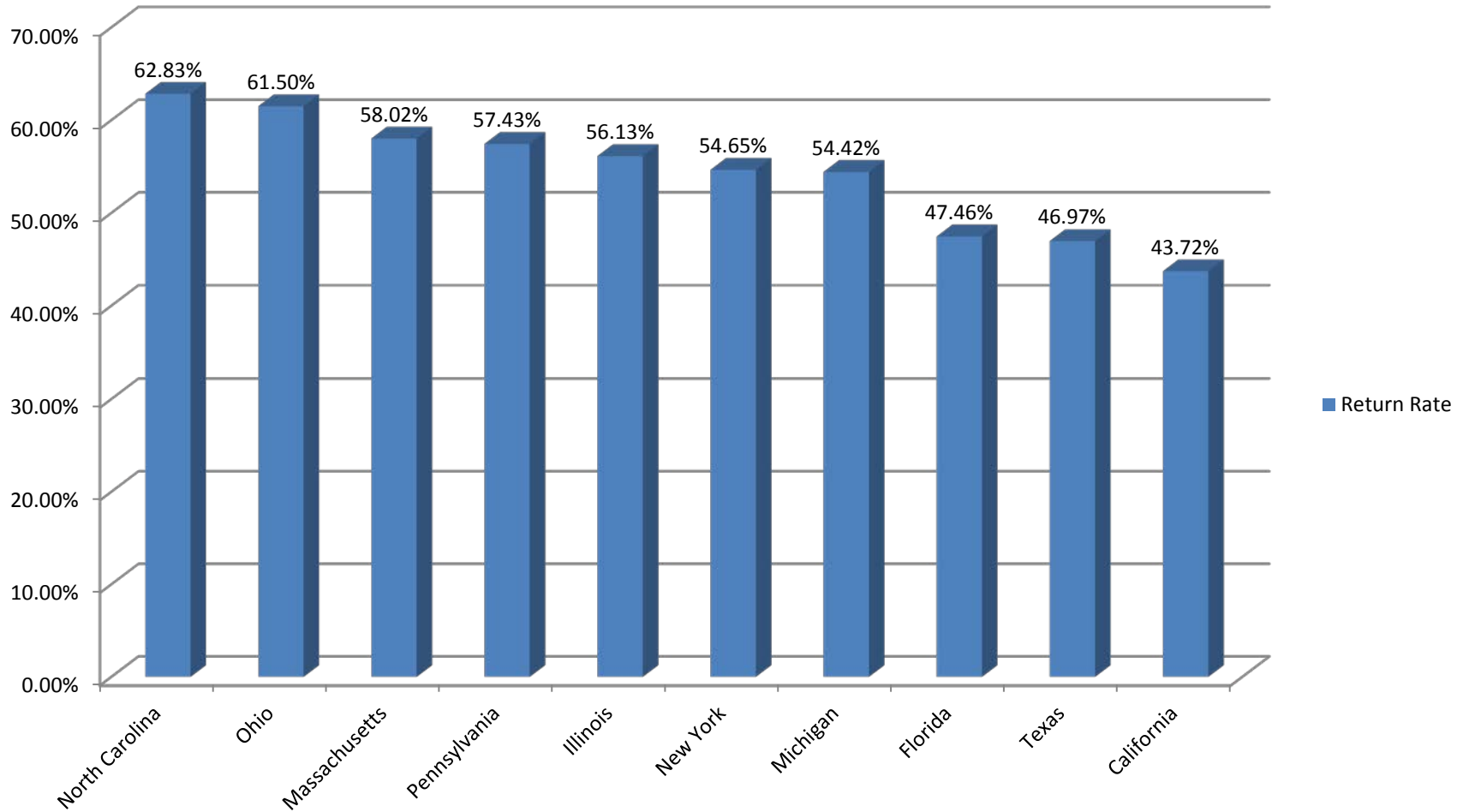
Total Dollars Paid by State



Totals are through December 2014

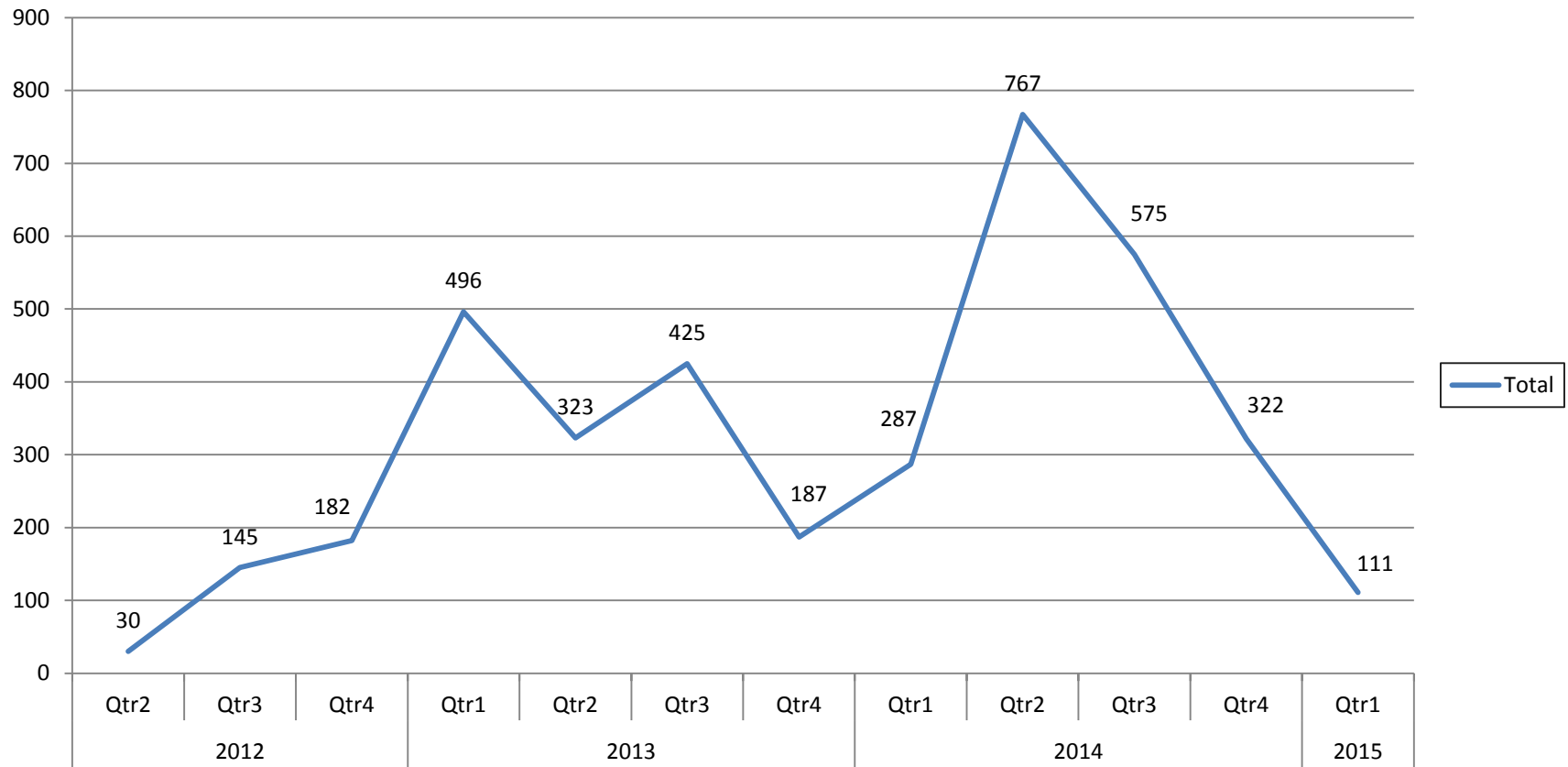
National Perspective

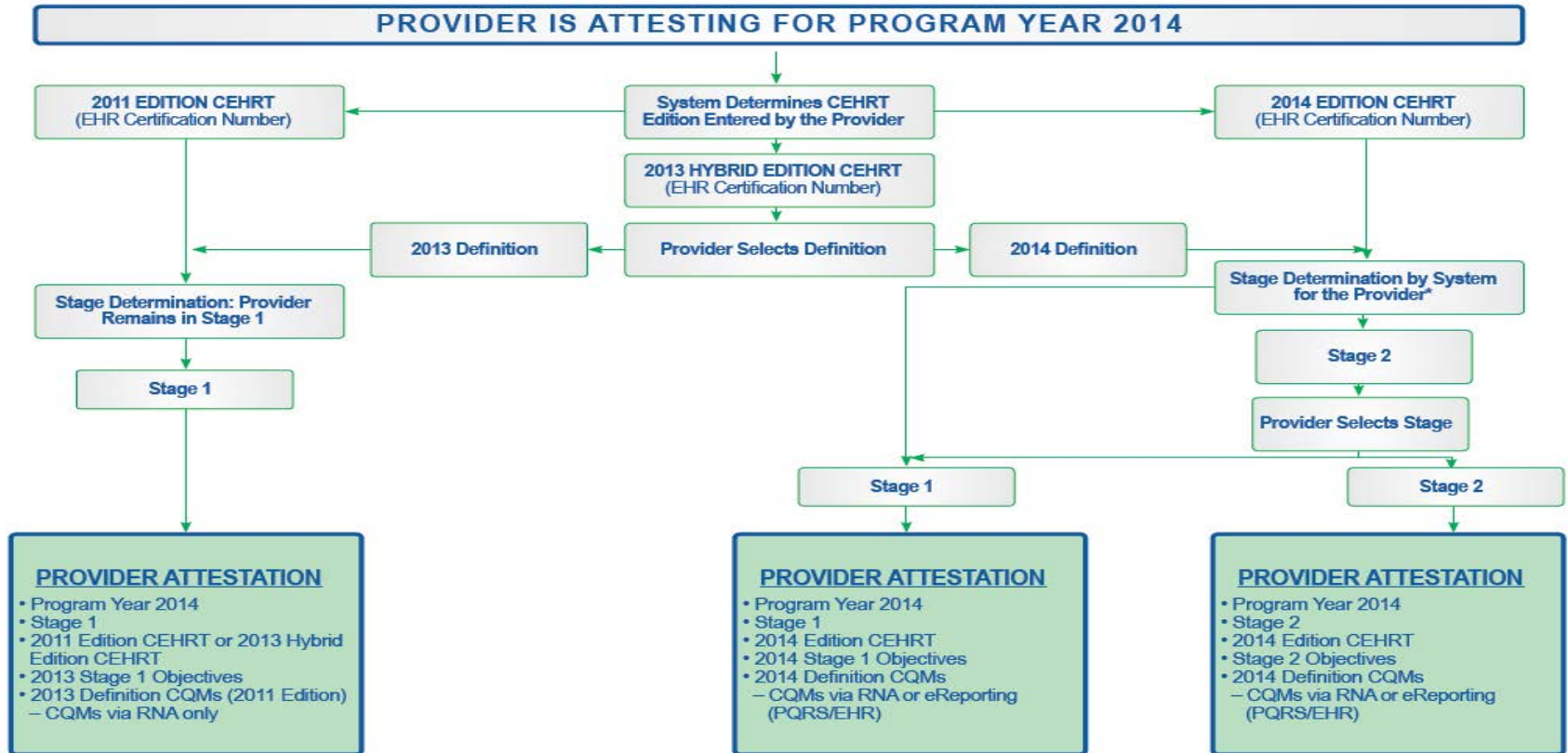

Stage 3 Notice of Proposed Rulemaking

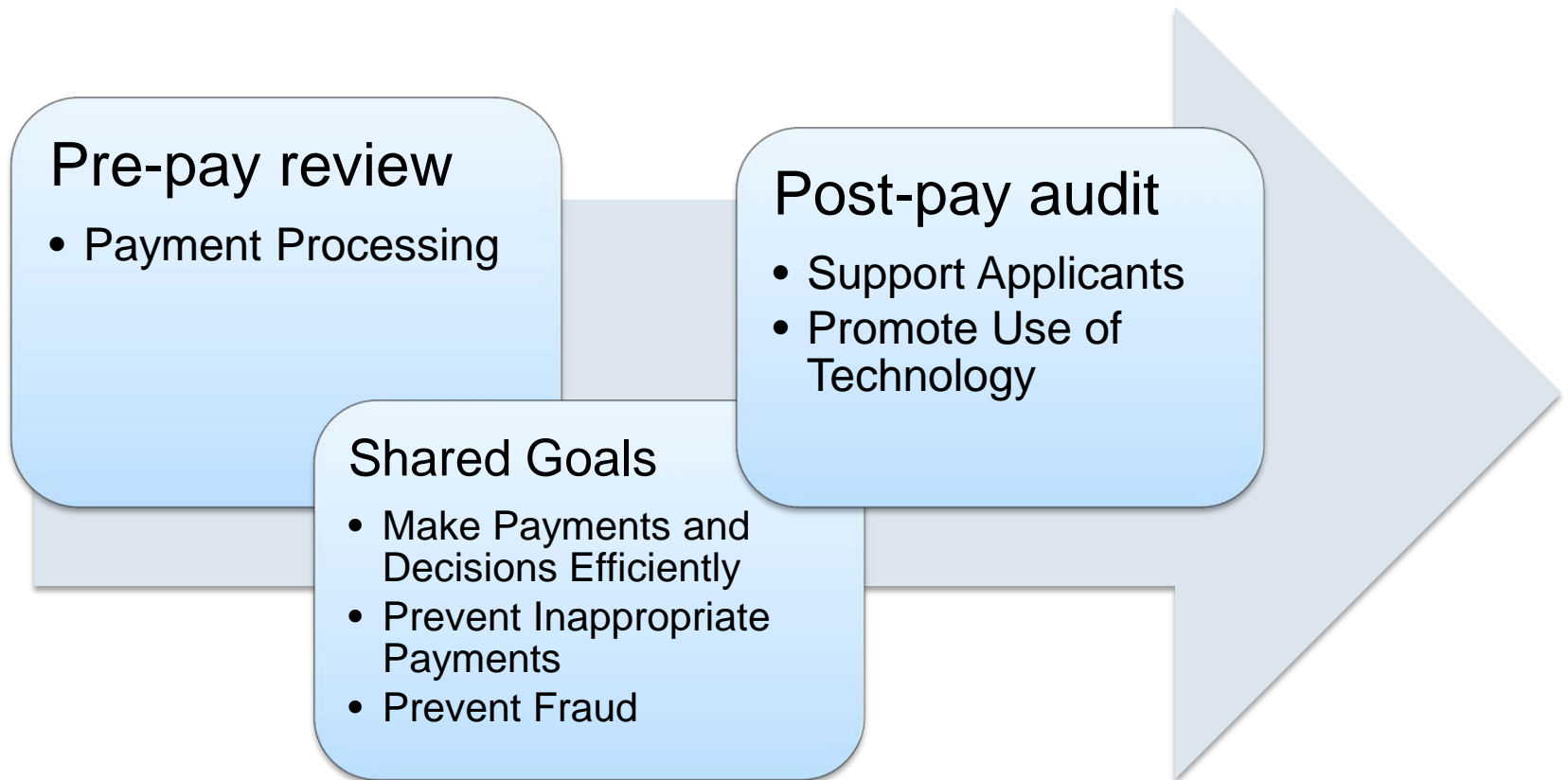
- It is projected that the Stage 3 NPRM will be released for comments in February
- There will be a comment period and then a review period and then the Final Rule will be published
- The Stage 3 Meaningful Use measures will start in 2017

CMS Announces Intent to Engage in Rulemaking for EHR Incentive Program Changes for 2015

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) intends to engage in rulemaking this spring to help ensure providers continue to meet meaningful use requirements.

- **Shortening the 2015 reporting period to 90 days** to address provider concerns about their ability to fully deploy 2014 Edition software
- **Realigning hospital reporting periods to the calendar year** to allow eligible hospitals more time to incorporate 2014 Edition software into their workflows and to better align with other quality programs
- **Modifying other aspects of the programs** to match long-term goals, reduce complexity, and lessen providers' reporting burden

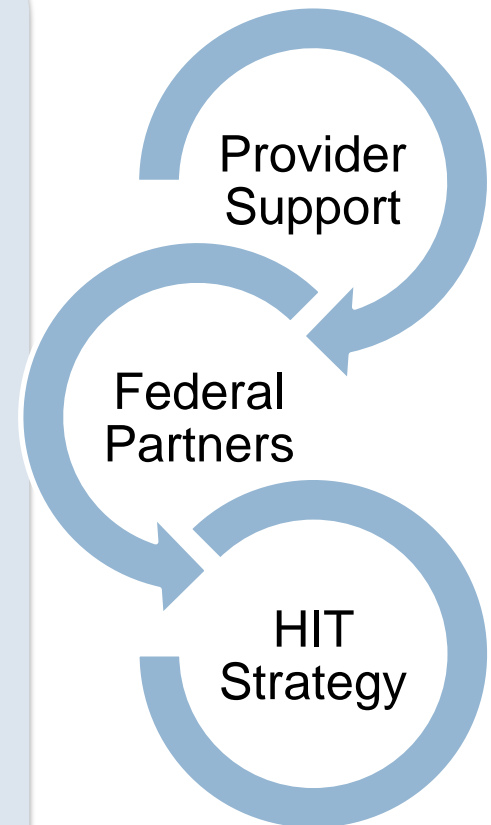

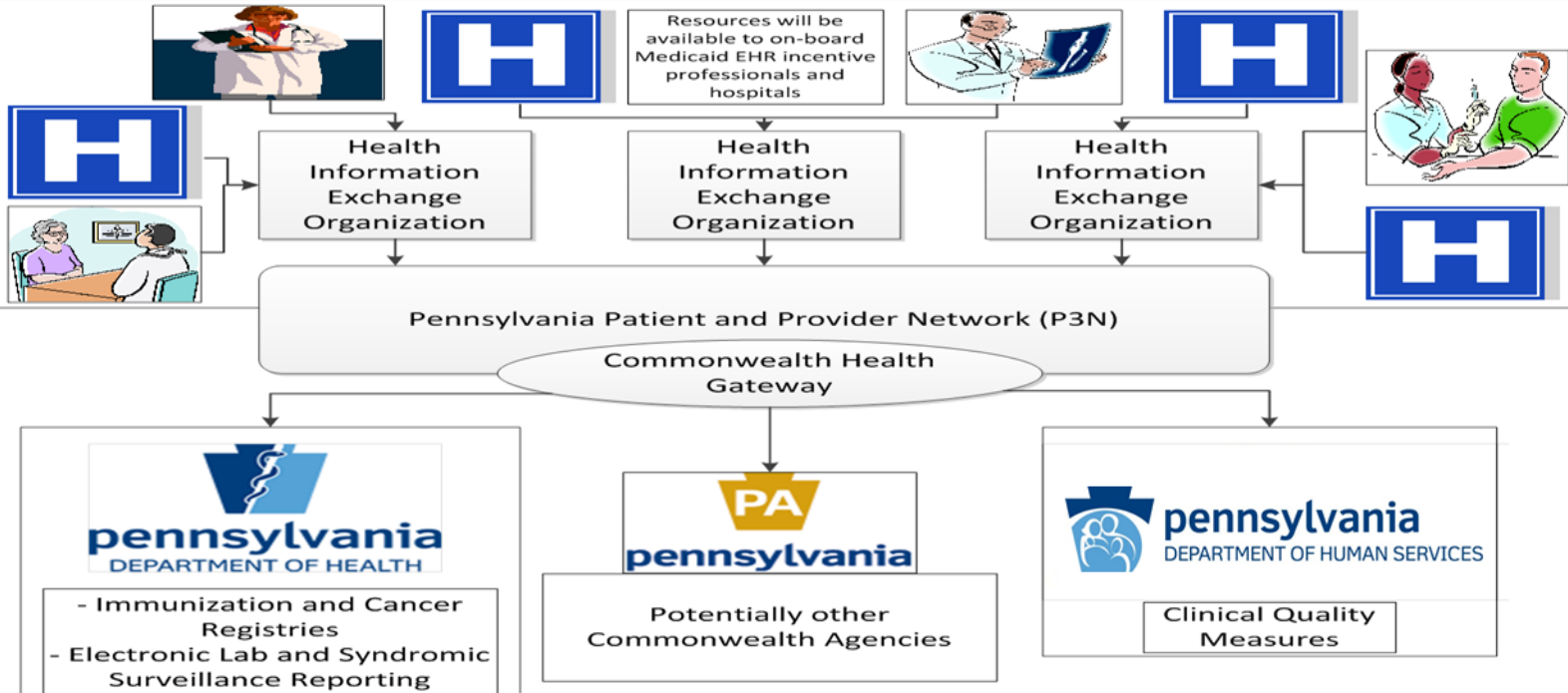

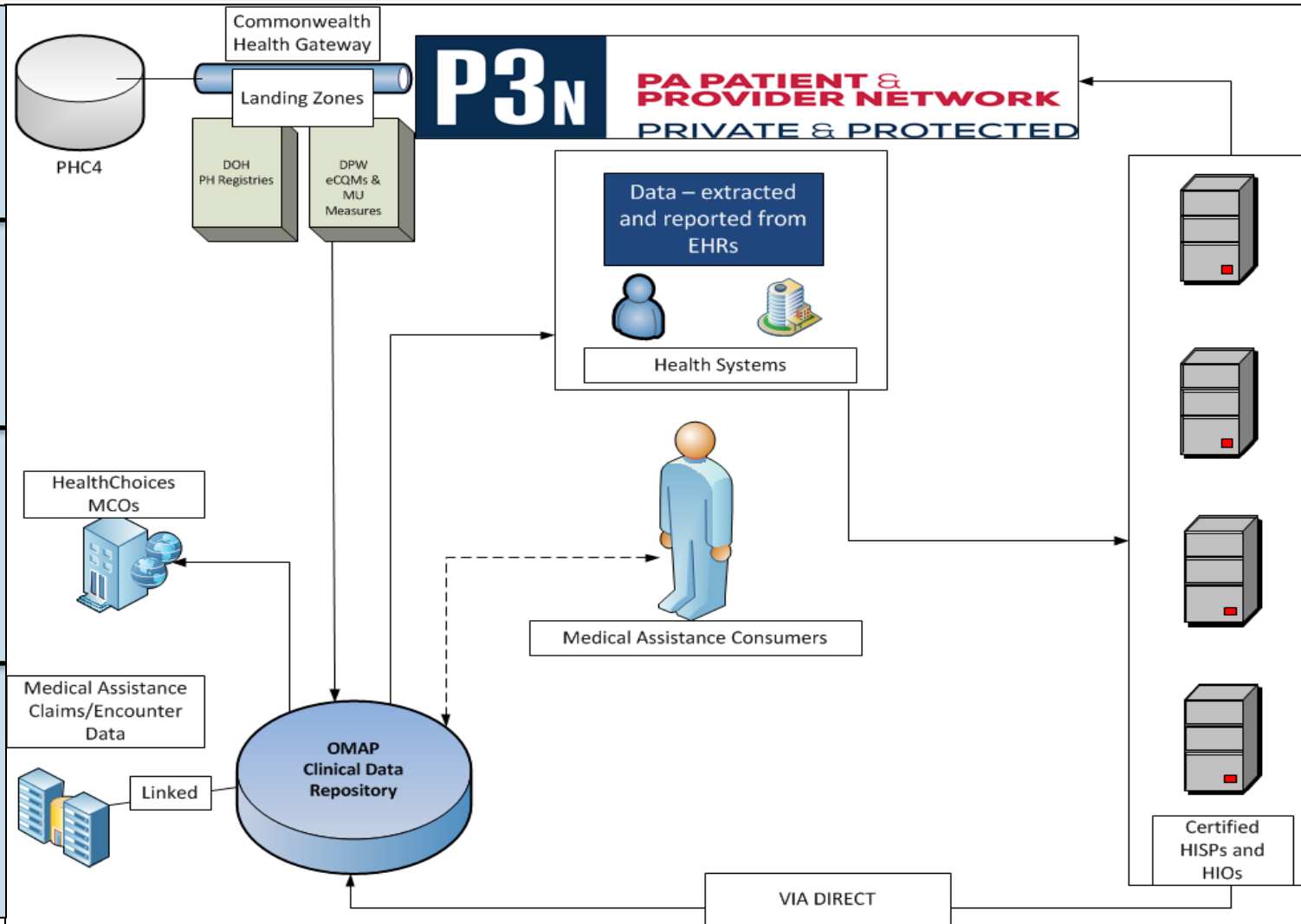
